**AT GROUND ZERO**

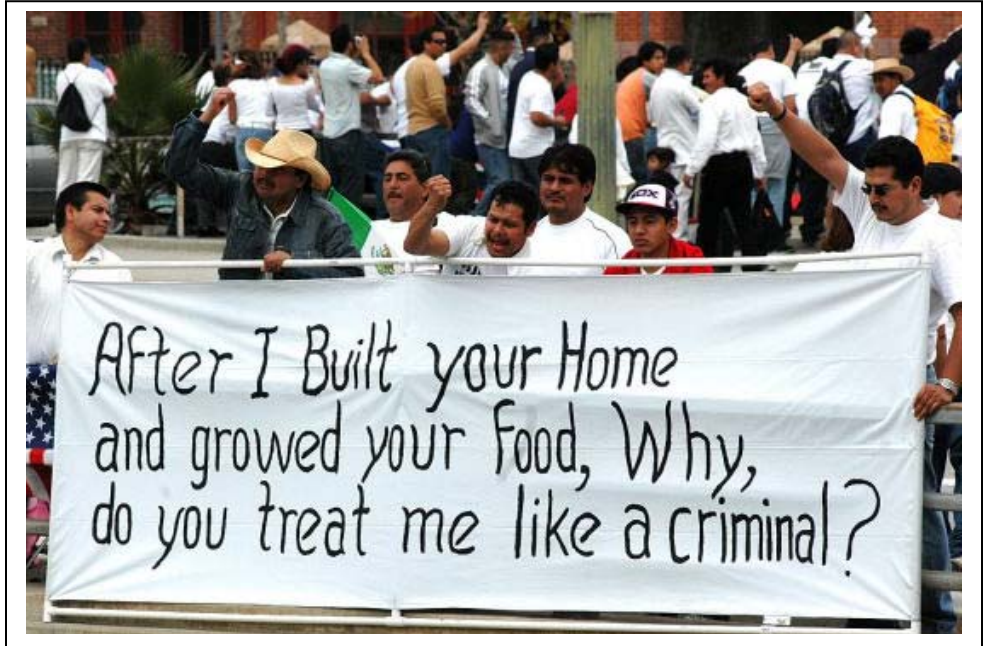

Many innocent victims perished on September 11<sup>th</sup>, 2001. Most are remembered. *The forgotten ones* are the many unaccounted for undocumented workers who died. They have not been acknowledged; nor have their dependents been recognized or compensated in any way.

Since that day many hundreds of undocumented workers have been employed for the clean-up and decontamination of ground zero and the surrounding community. Today, New Yorkers and people from around the world live, work, and visit a environmentally safer Lower Manhattan, yet many of those who made it possible paid it with their health and even their lives.



Much of the labor that built the Twin Towers was Immigrant Labor, many undocumented, amongst them. Many undocumented died crossing the border. Many survived the crossing, and died on 9/11. Many more are suffering the health effects of 9/11 or have since died.
